



New Pool Tips for Operation (Time Clock System)

1. Your pool has been wired with a mechanical timer that will turn your pool pump on and off.
 - a. To set time, pull the yellow wheel toward you.
 - b. There are 2 timer pins that unscrew and can be set to ON/OFF times. Do not over-tighten or set crooked.
2. Your pumps are protected with GFCI type breakers that should be checked monthly. If breakers do not reset or trip repeatedly, call **Kel-Rob Electric** for service.
3. Your pool lights are operated by a switch located in a designated location—varies from home to home. If your pool light does not work, check 20 amp breaker or check reset button located on pool panel. If the light repeatedly trips, call **Kel-Rob Electric** for service. **DO NOT**, at any time, try taking light apart either in or out of the swimming pool, which could result in serious injury or death from electrical shock. This GFCI should also be checked monthly.
4. If your pool has a salt chlorination system, it will operate only when the pump circuit is on and your pool is running.
5. Your heater, whether gas or a heat pump, will only operate when there is water flow. Heater must be set to desired temperature in order to operate. Clogged filters or obstructions can cause heaters from working.
6. Your swimming pool is bonded by NEC guidelines and has been inspected by a professional. If at any time, these bonding wires become disconnected, call **Kel-Rob Electric** for service.
7. Under no circumstances should any kind of electrical appliances be used near a swimming pool.
8. Never open or try to operate anything in your pool panel if you are wet, or in the rain or snow.
9. Always have a responsible adult turn any electrical devices on or off.
10. Remember your swimming pool is wired to NEC Code for your protection. Do not allow anyone who claims to know about electrical wiring—or a neighbor who does wiring as a hobby—touch your swimming pool electric. Swimming pool companies are not licensed or certified to do electrical work. Call **Kel-Rob Electric** for service. Safety is utmost importance.
